IN-LINE INITIATOR

DESCRIPTION:

An environmentally sealed fitting (patent pending) that initiates shock tubing. It is permanently applied to the shock tube at the factory on the end of the shock tube that is opposite the detonator. The In-Line Initiator consists of an aluminum end fitting attached to the shock tube. The fitting is loaded with a primer that reliably initiates shock tube and has a 7/16"-20 nut for mating the in-line initiator to any standard shock tube firing device.

FEATURES:

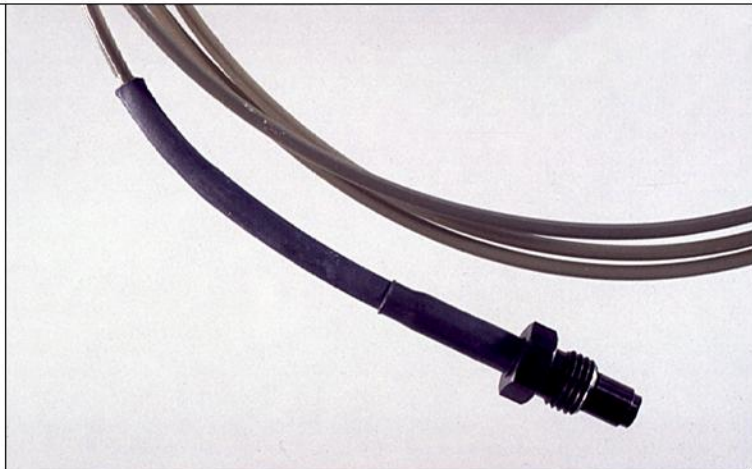
- Factory assembled to the shock tube to insure reliability

- Withstands twenty five pound pull force without separating from shock tube
- 7/16-20 nut mates with MK 31 projector, MK 55 MOD 0 Hand Held Firing Device, M142 Multipurpose Demolition Firing Device, or other firing pin devices
